#### What's the Same?

Vestry Resource Guide = resource to guide vestry in their ministry

- Leadership role (shared with rector)
  - Discernment of God's call
  - Identification of new leaders
  - Stewardship and development of resources
- Fiduciary role
- Special duties when congregation without a rector

Approach: What we know about congregations today

- Reflects the changing landscape of an increasingly secular world
- Strong focus on discerning mission & vision (what is God calling us to do?)
- Value of team approach to engaging in the work of ministry
- · Importance of identifying, nurturing, supporting new leaders

What's Different: 2 A's and an F

Acknowledgment: Congregations differ due to context

- > 45% PT, supply, or no clergy
- Increasing number of Spanish speaking members
- Blended congregations or multiple sharing one space
- · No longer can assume building based
- Church plants/emergent may take different form


