Let's not let anything stop us from getting started...



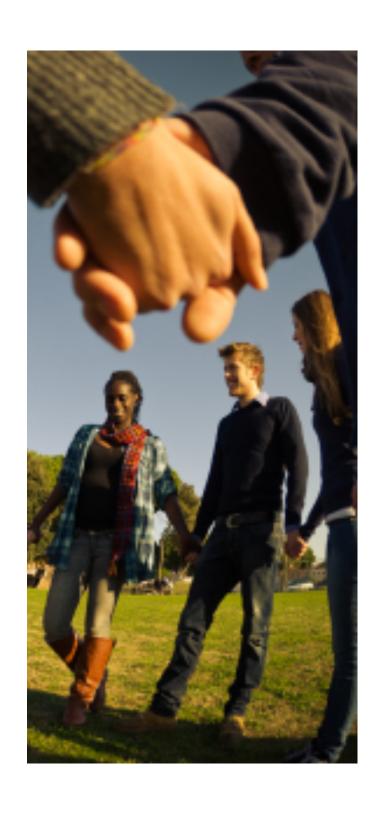
Year Round Stewardship
