

## Episcopal Ministry Funding Sources

### Local funding options:

- 1) Diocesan: Contact diocesan treasurer, Canon to the Ordinary, Bishop(s), Congregational Development officer and inquire about grants to assist in funding mission ministries.
- 2) Region: Contact dean or regional president to inquire about congregations with outreach and mission funds; local clergy's discretionary funds.
- 3) Community: Network through Rotary Clubs, Lions Clubs, Masonic lodges, community foundations, local banks, local businesses, and family foundations (these are not typically public information, requires knowing a member of the family; clergy may can point you to this resource).
